

Uniform Washing Instructions

Uniforms are washed after every performance, if time allows.

Uniforms should be washed in cold water and can be put in a dryer on MEDIUM setting. Wash all the bibs together and all the jackets together. Please be sure the uniforms are DRY before re-bagging for return.

The rhinestone patch and gauntlets should NOT be washed. If they are wet (due to rain) please open the bags to allow them to air-dry or lay them out to dry. Remove the C for washing. The rhinestone patch and the “C” can be left in the uniform bag which makes it easier to place them back on the correct uniform. Some uniforms will not have C’s due to the instrument that they play being in the way of the C.

Each bag has a designated number that is for a specific band member. The hanger has much information referenced. The hanger documents the bag number in addition to the control number of the jacket and bib for that particular student. The control numbers are written on the tag of each jacket and bib.

After washing, match up the bib and jacket control number to the corresponding information that is documented on the hangar. This way each band student receives back their same uniform. The size of the sparkly should match or closely match the size of the jacket.

Let Sarah or Mary know if you see any hems or zippers needing sewing attention. If you have the skills to fix the hem, we would appreciate if you would go ahead and do this for us.

Uniforms are to be returned to the truck/trailer in the west stadium parking lot by Tuesday or Wednesday of the following week from 5:30 – 6.
